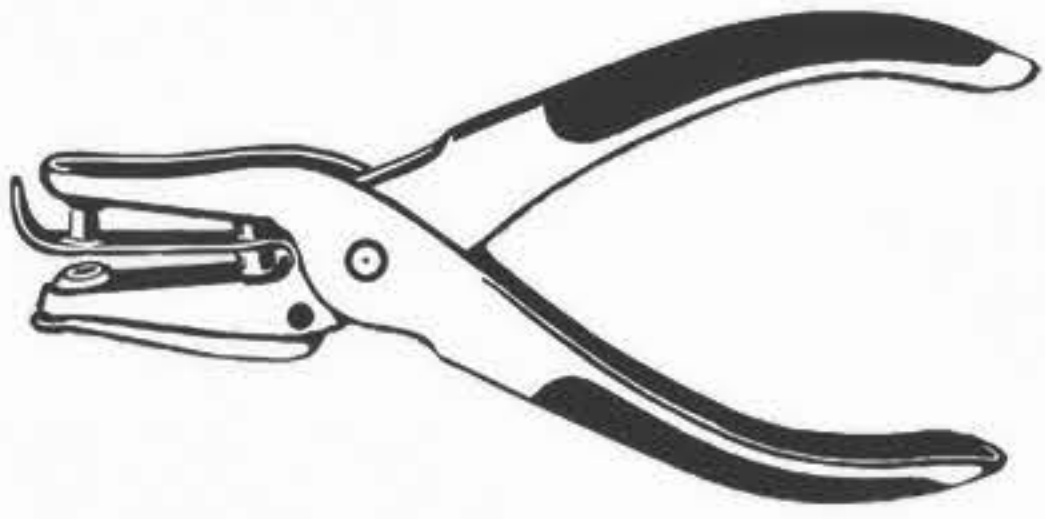


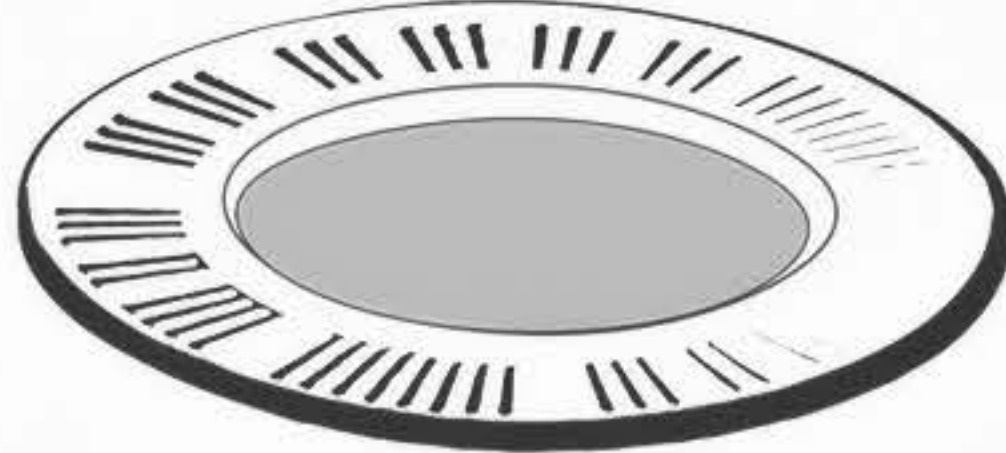
TAMBOURINE

REQUIRED MATERIALS

1 HOLE PUNCHER



1 PAPER PLATE
(size may vary)



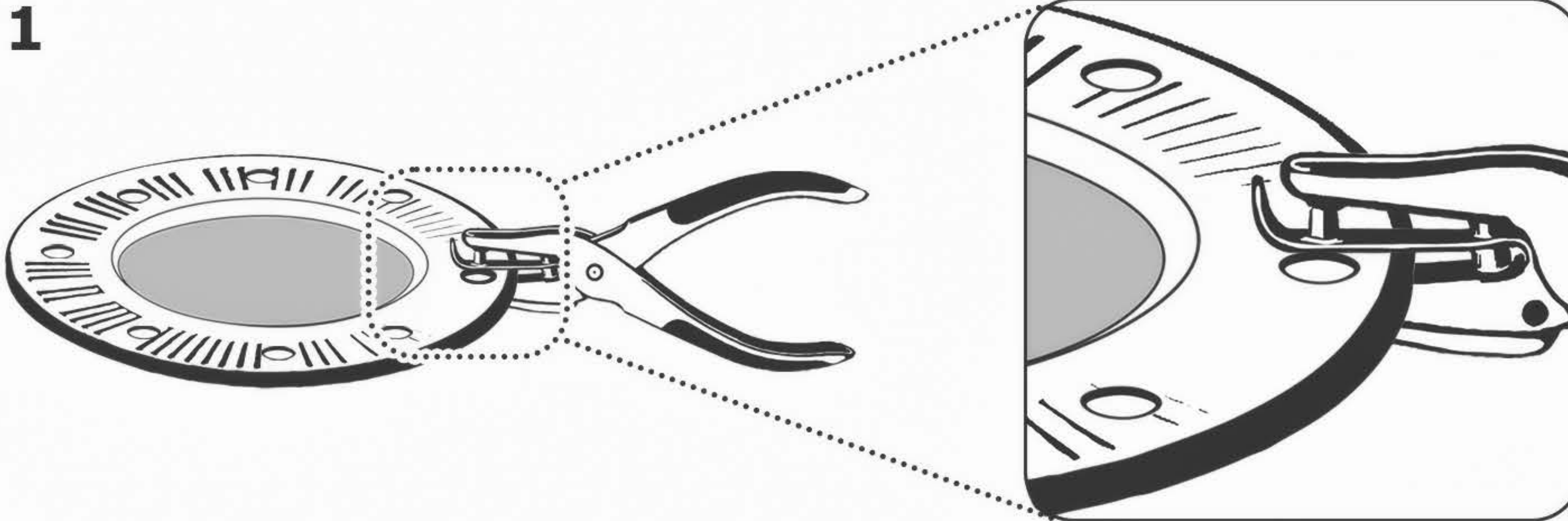
8 PIPE CLEANERS



8 JINGLE BELLS

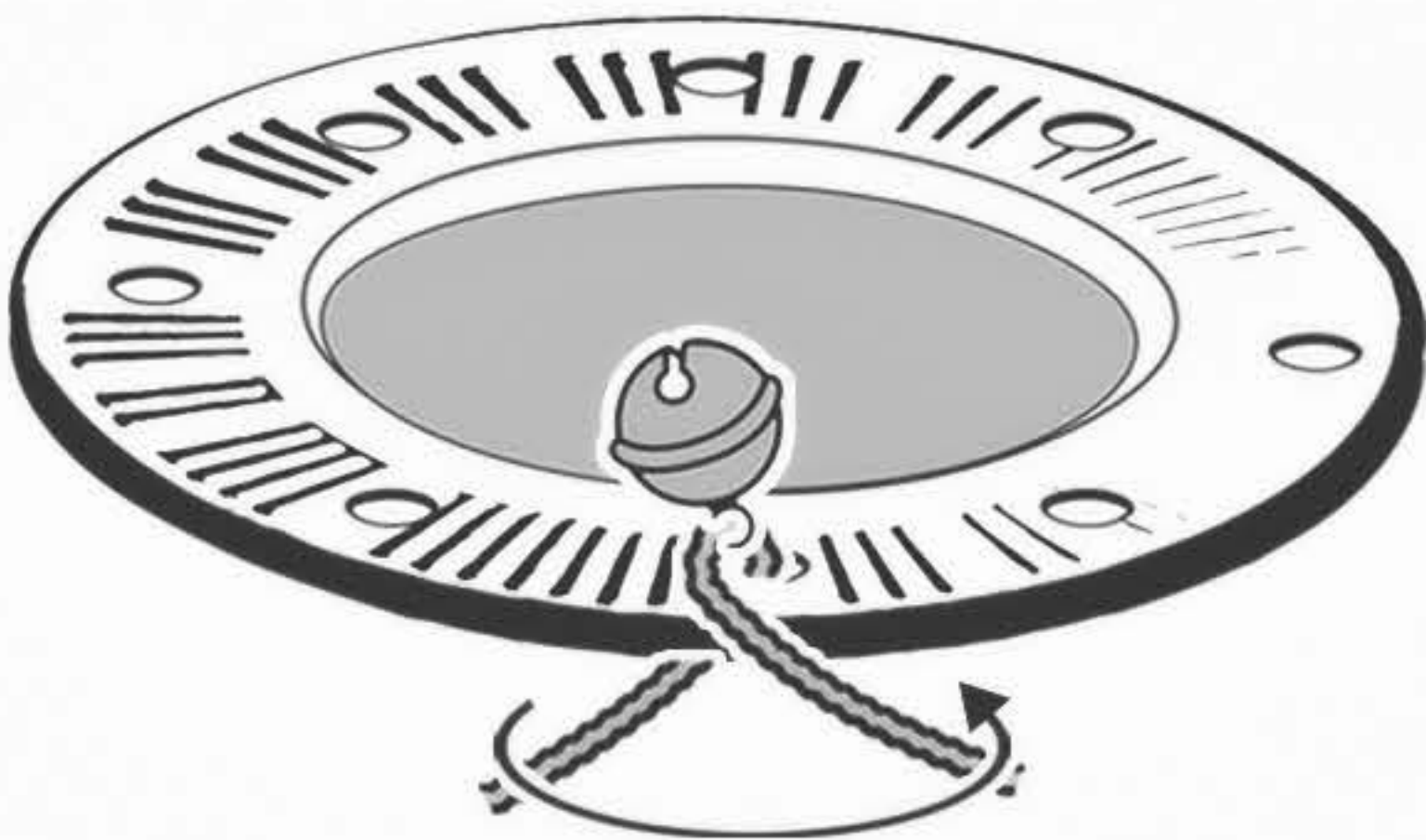
Step 1: Using a hole puncher, make evenly spaced holes around the outer edge of a paper plate.

Step 2: Thread a small bell onto a pipe cleaner.

Step 3: Take one end of the pipe cleaner with the bell and thread it through one of the holes you punched in the paper plate. Pull it all the way through, leaving the bells hanging on the inside of the plate.

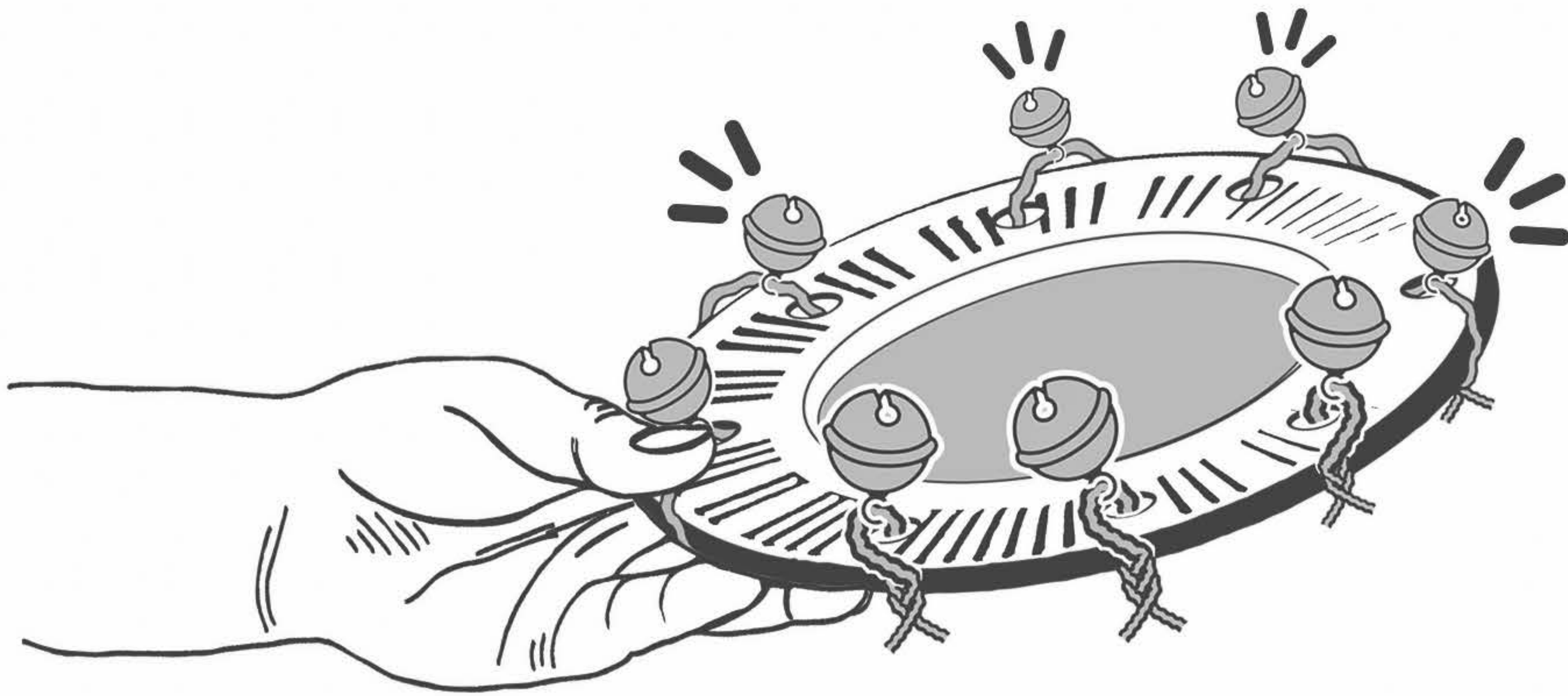

Step 4: On the backside of the paper plate, twist the ends of the pipe cleaner to secure it in place.

Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the remaining holes.

TAMBOURINE



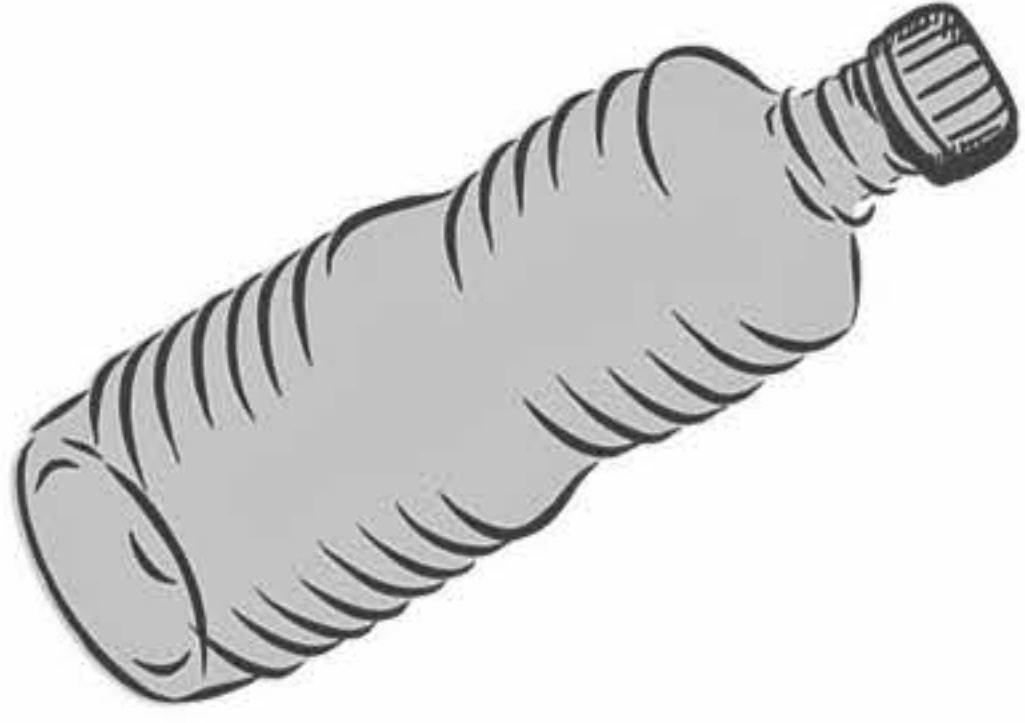
Great job! You've made **a tambourine**.

To use it, grip the tambourine with one hand and shake it back and forth.

SHAKER

REQUIRED MATERIALS

1 EMPTY WATER BOTTLE
(size may vary)



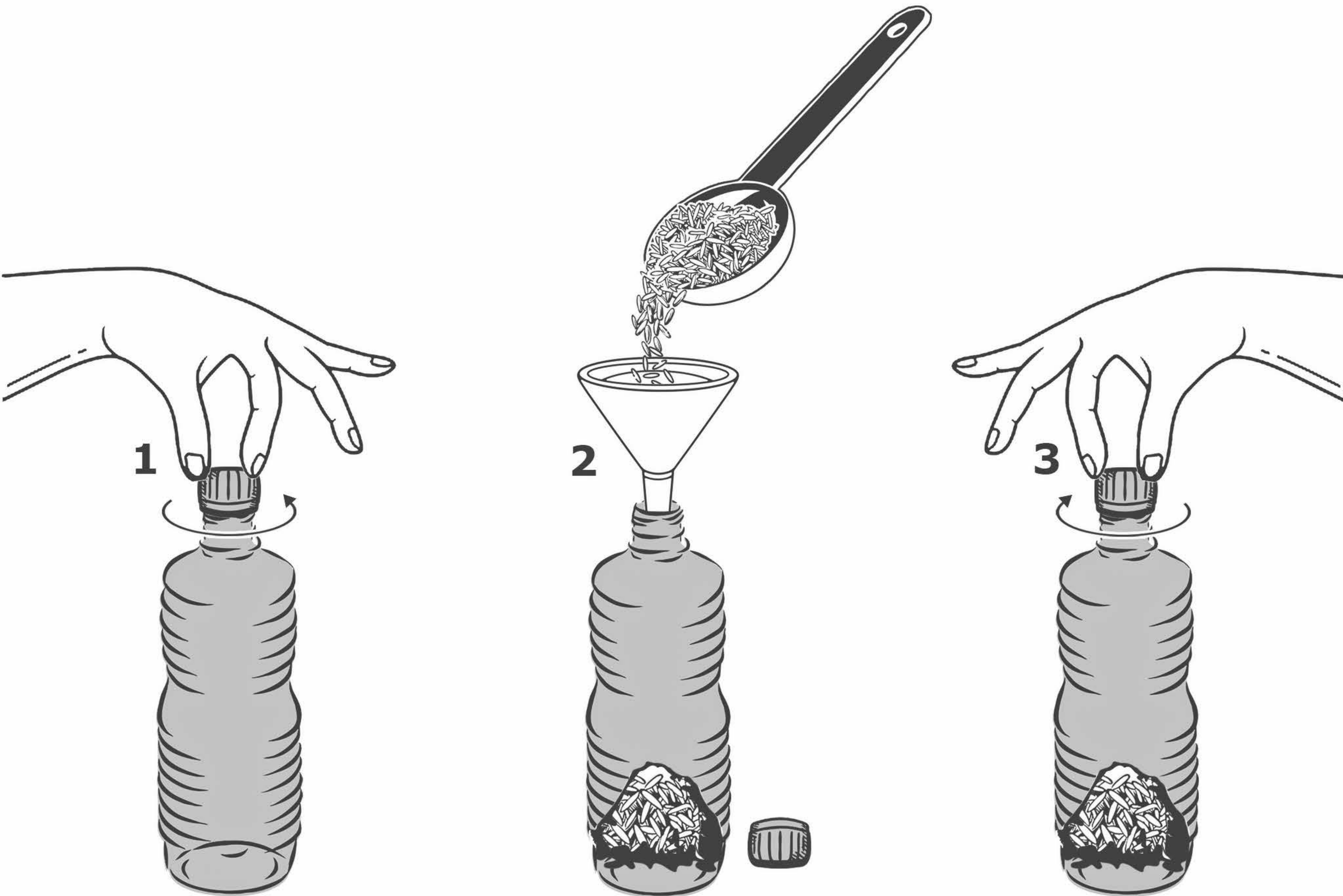
1 MEASURING SPOON
(OPTIONAL)



1 FUNNEL
(OPTIONAL)



DRY RICE
(1/4 CUP)

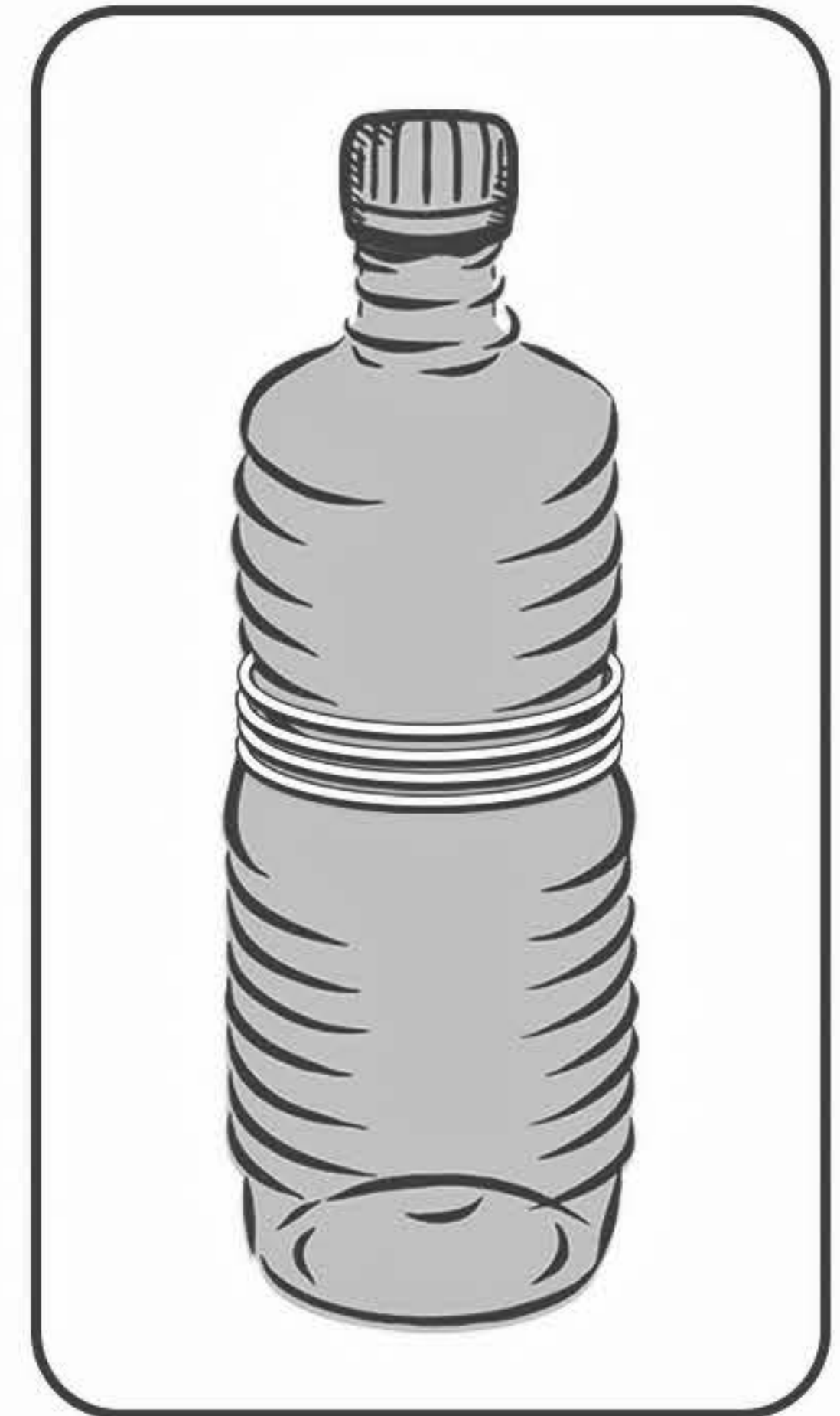
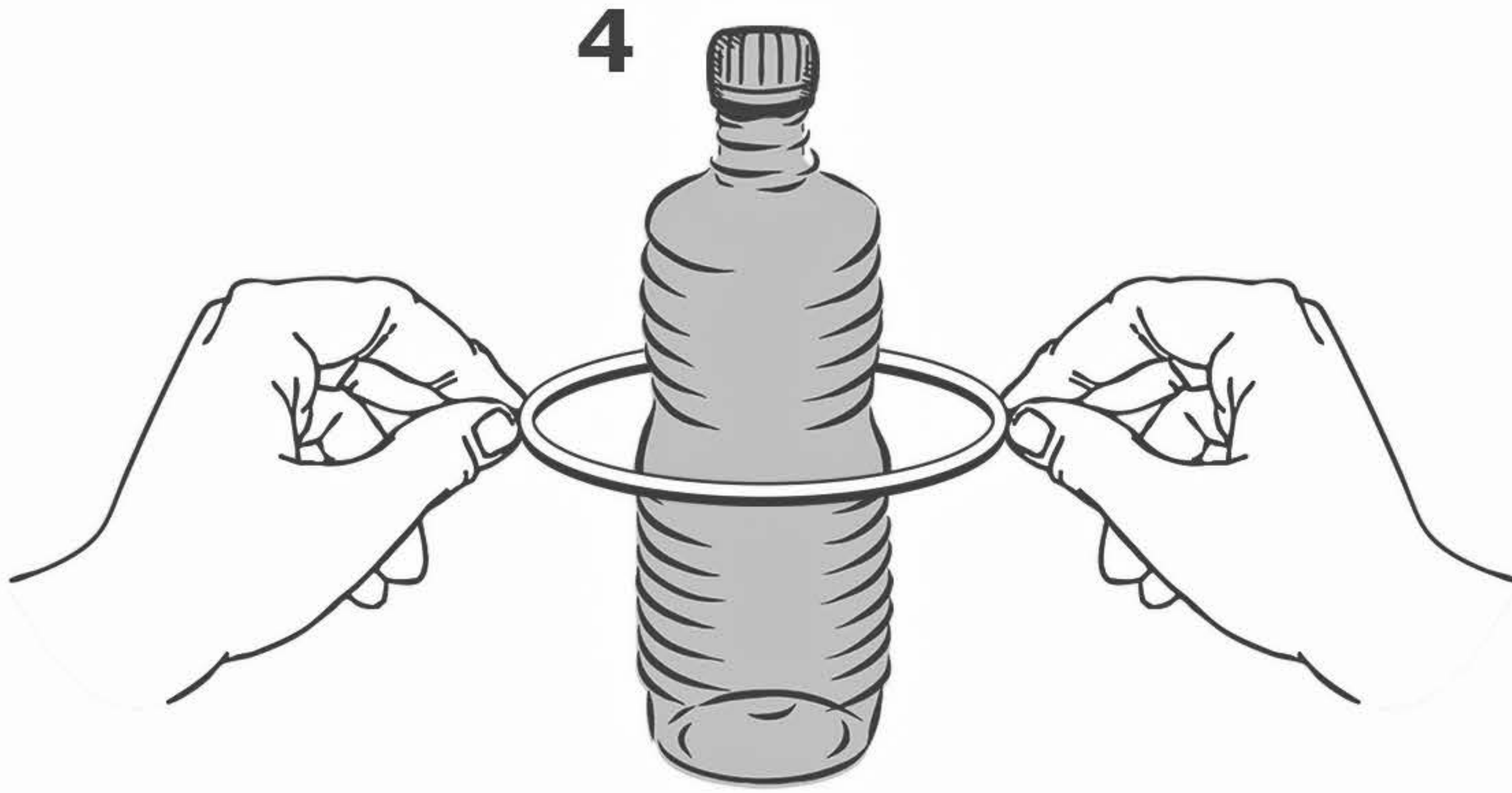


Step 1: Unscrew the cap of an empty water bottle.

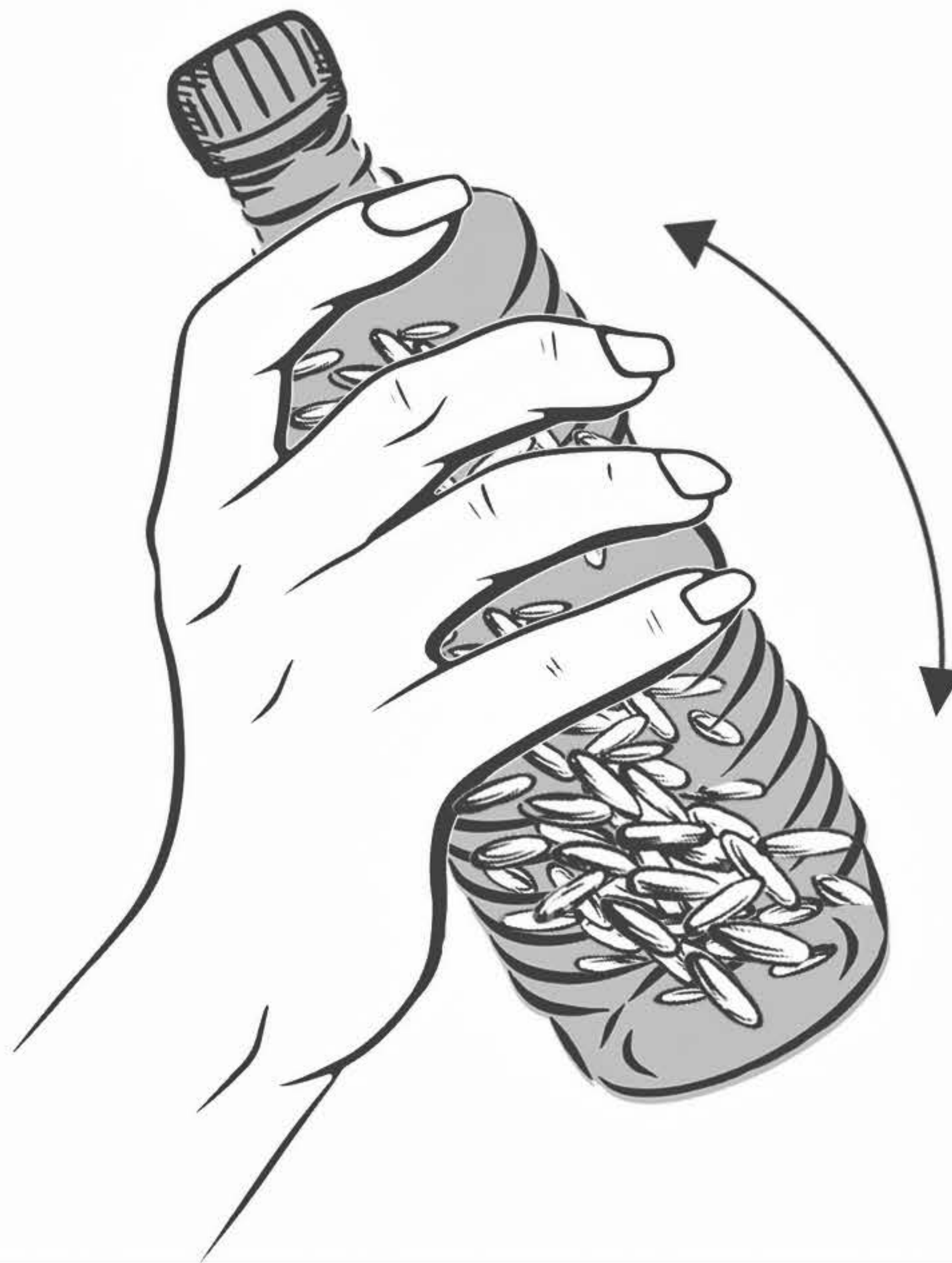
Step 2: Funnel rice into the bottle until it's about one-fourth full.

Step 3: Screw the cap back on tightly.

SHAKER



Step 4 (optional): Stretch elastic bands over the middle of the bottle for a secure grip for holding the shaker. Make sure the elastic bands not too tight so as to distort the shape of the bottle.



Great job! You've made **a shaker**.

To use it, grip the bottle with one or both hands and shake it up-and-down or side-to-side.

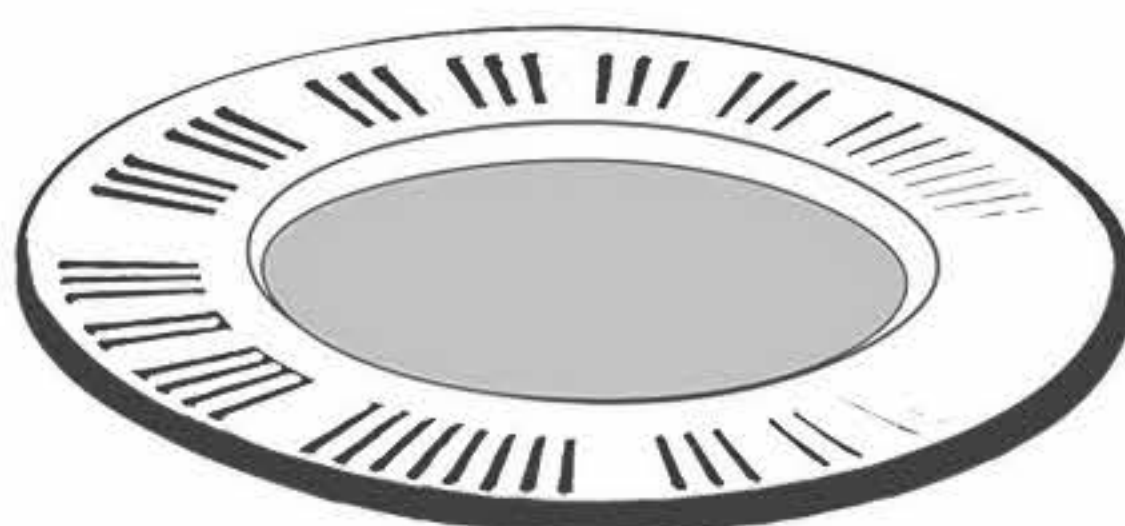
CASTANET

REQUIRED MATERIALS

1 HOT GLUE GUN
(or strong craft glue/super glue)



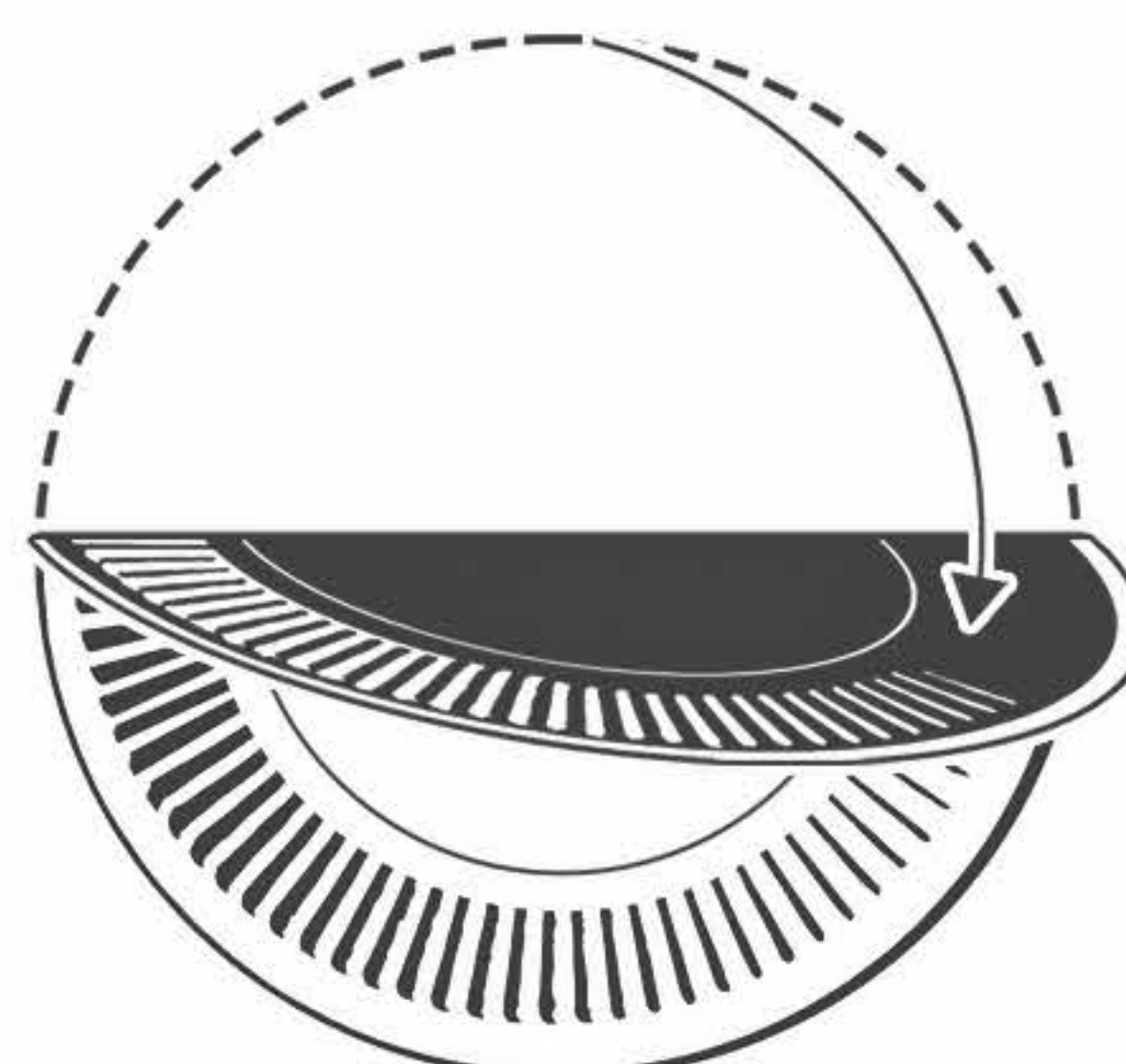
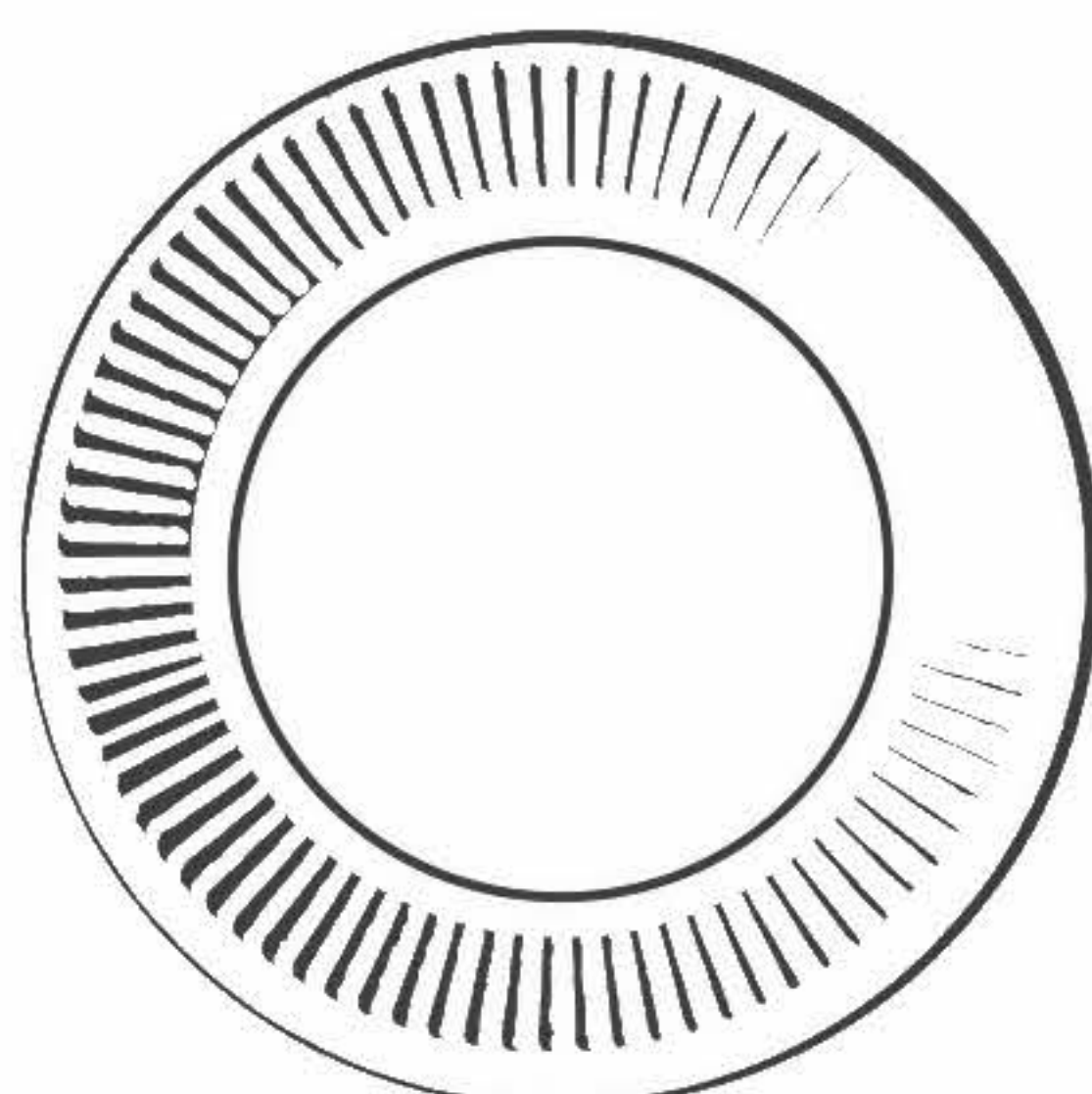
1 PAPER PLATE
(size may vary)



8 COINS

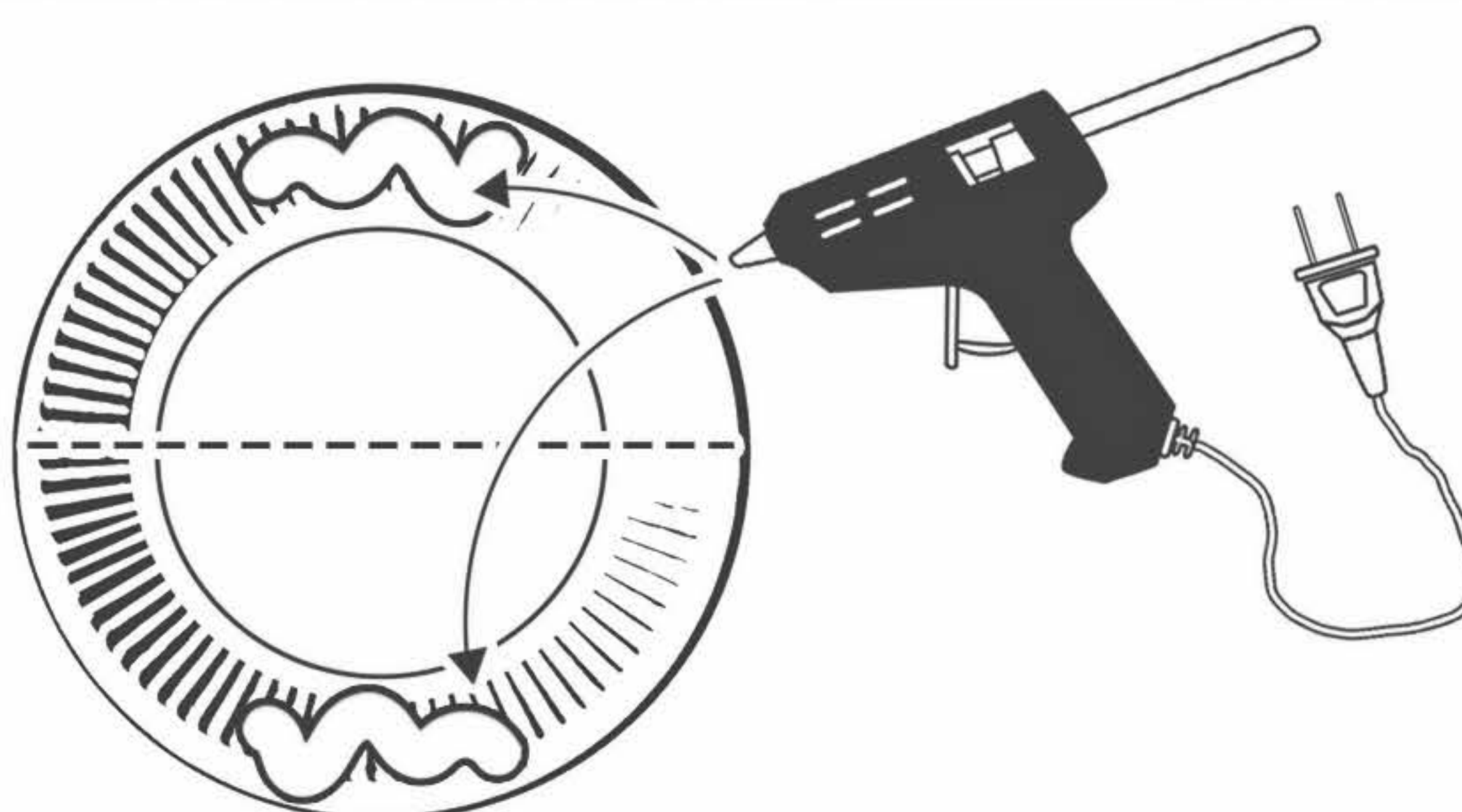

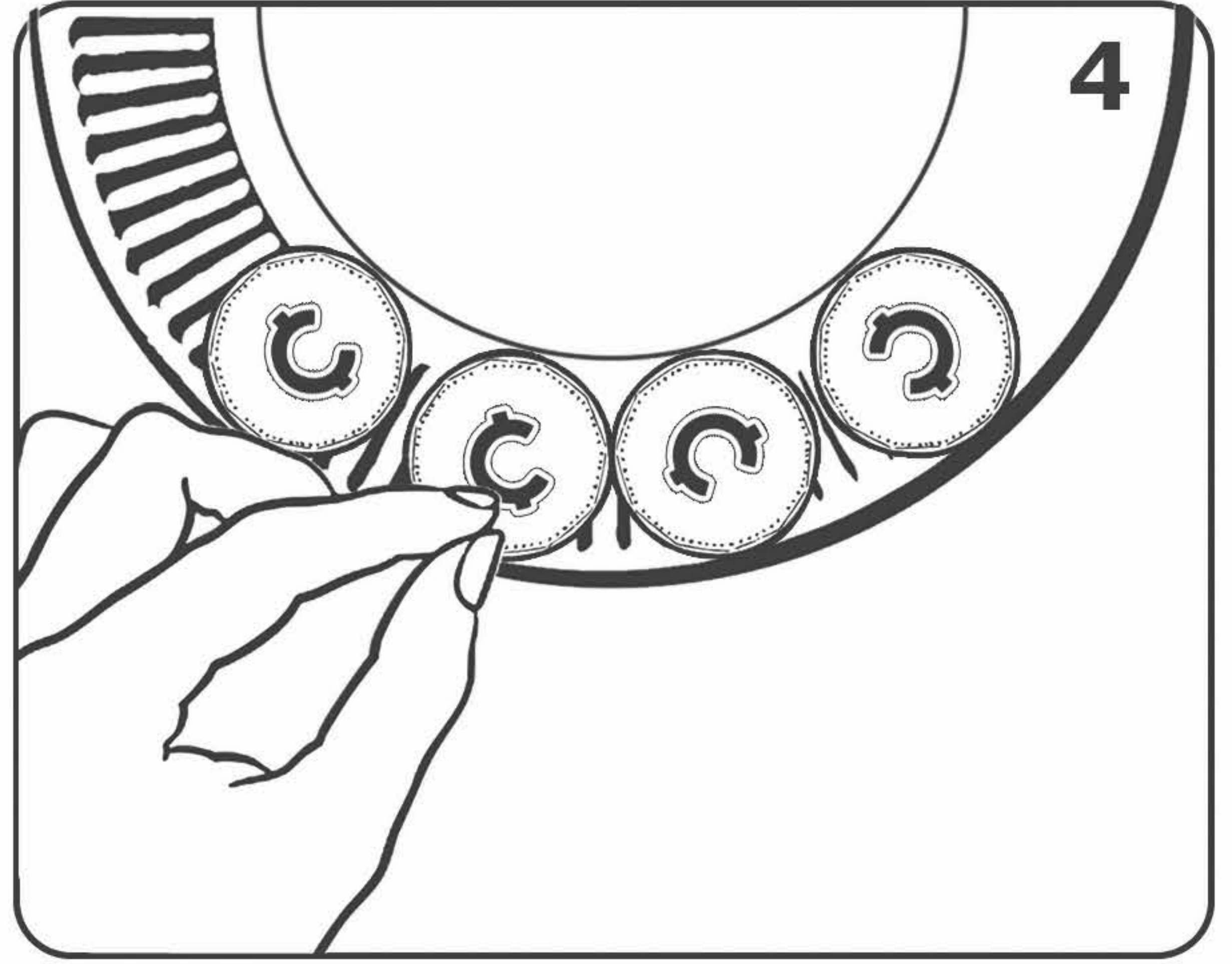
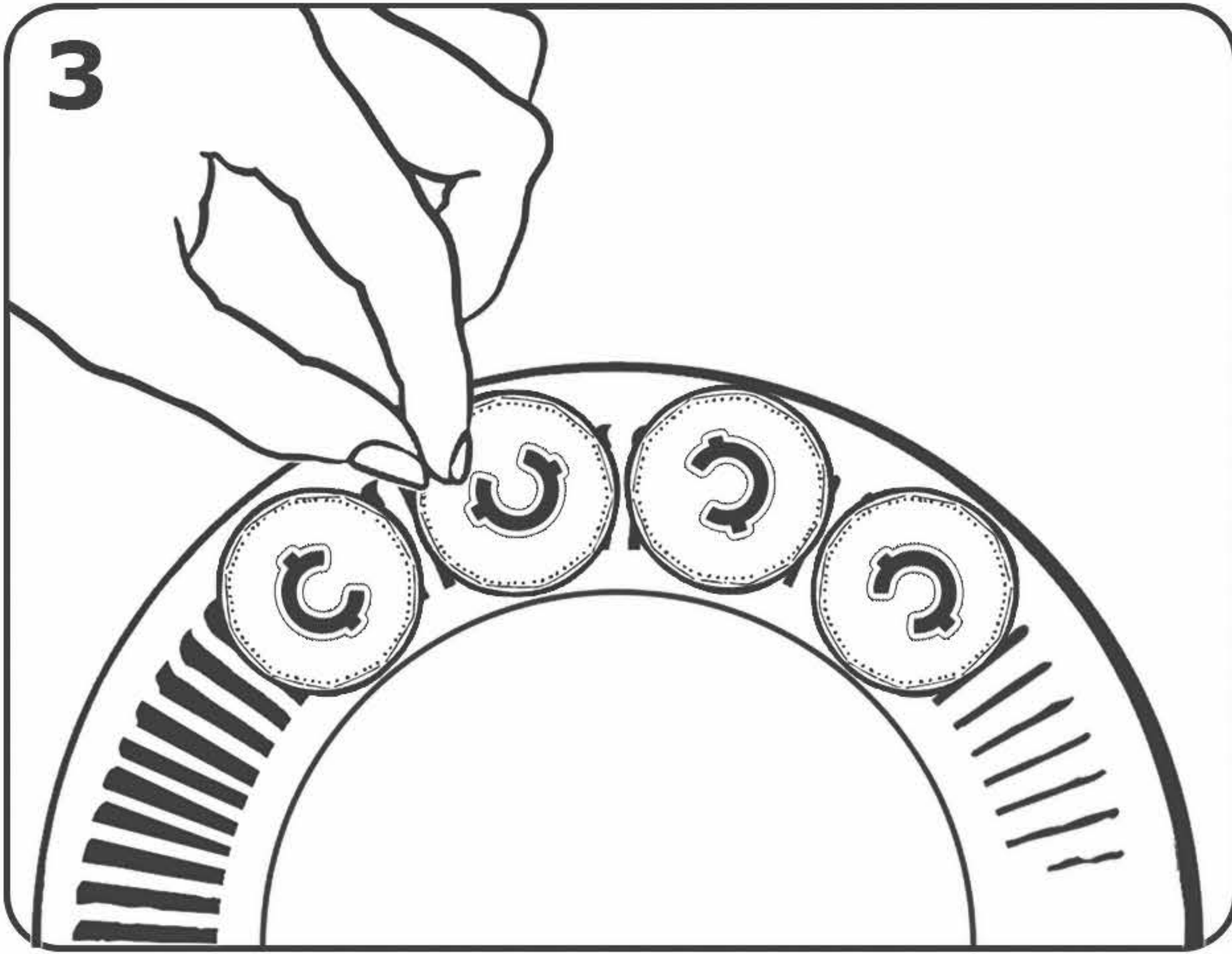
Step 1: Fold a paper plate in half, making sure the folded edges align perfectly.

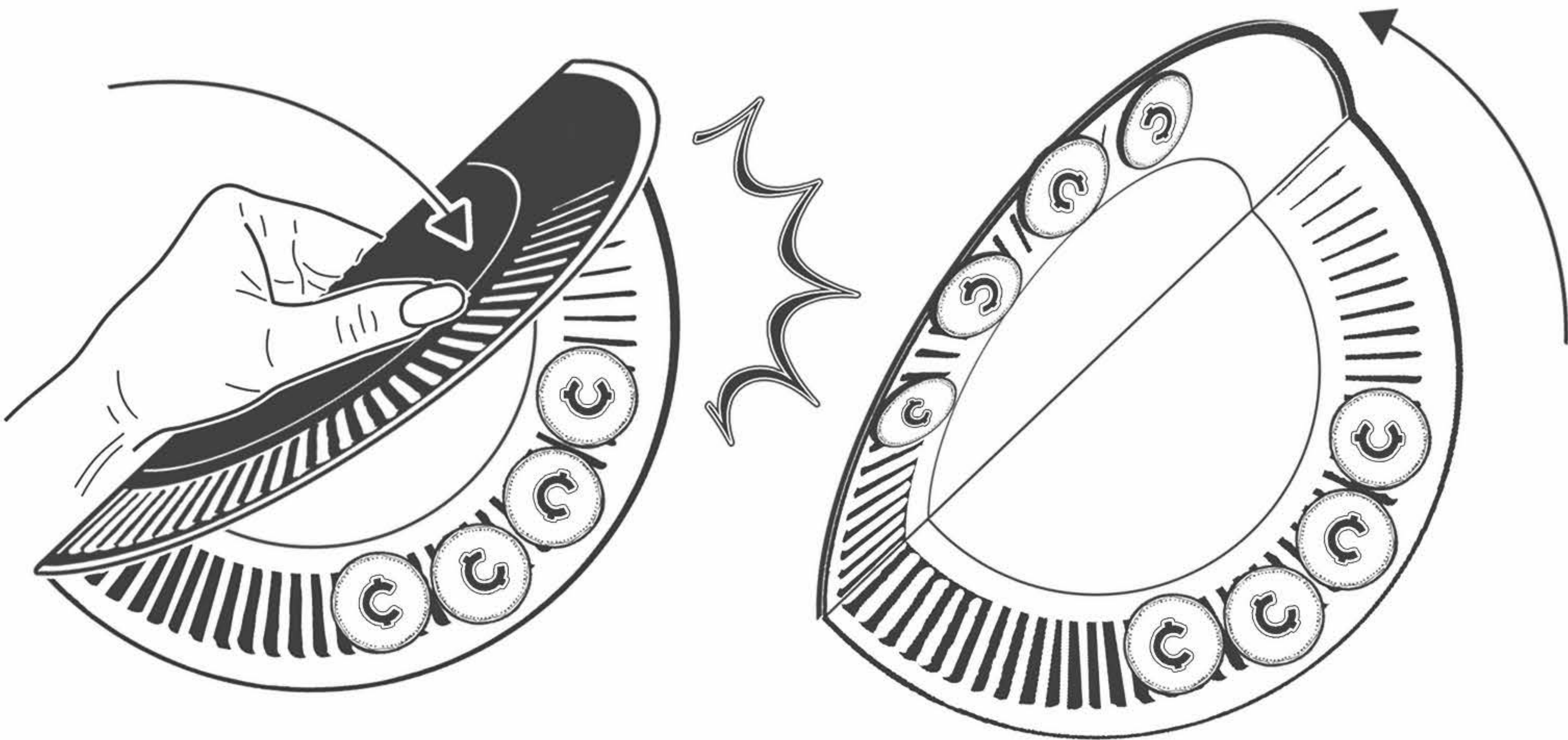
CAUTION: Keep fingers away from the hot tip of the glue gun, and be mindful of where the glue is being applied. For your safety, have an adult present to provide guidance, supervision, or assistance.

Step 2: Open the folded plate. Using a hot glue gun, apply a generous amount of hot glue to opposite ends on the inner edge of the plate.



CAUTION: Be mindful as to not touch the hot glue as it can cause burns.

Step 3: While the hot glue is still hot and tacky, press coins down firmly onto the glue spots at both ends of the folded paper plate. Allow the hot glue to cool and harden completely for a few minutes.



Great job! You've made a **castanet**.

To use it, hold your castanet by the folded edge and pinch your fingers together. As you do this, the coins will come into contact and create a clapping or clicking sound.
